Our polyurethane foams designated with a suffix "C" comply with all applicable provisions of the California Bureau of Home Furnishings Technical Bulletin #117.

All of the polyurethane products produced for Johnson Furniture comply with the California Technical Bulletin #117.

As required, this test is conducted under specific laboratory conditions. The results cannot be used as a demonstration of the performance of furnishings containing California 117 foam in flammability tests nor in actual fire conditions. Foam is tested without any contaminates, including adhesives.

It is important to note that all flexible polyurethane foams will burn if exposed to a sufficiently intense heat source. Some of the combustion characteristics of flexible polyurethane foams can be altered by varying formulations and including flame-retardants and other additives in production. However, all flexible polyurethane foams, whether they contain flame-retardants or not, should be considered and handled accordingly.
